

Documentation for Gold Award – Developmental Programs

In January 2017, construction began on the Saint John the Evangelist campus Parish Activities Center (PAC). The new center attached to the west side of the school building along Cyprus Creek Road was completed in January 2018. Included in the planning of the new space was a green space around the outside of the building. Around the outside closet to the building numerous shrubs were planted. Along the road and back side of the building 15 trees were planted, including deciduous and evergreens.



During the spring of 2018, 2 dead oaks were removed along the Ritchie Highway side of the property and 2 White Oak trees per Anne Arundel County permit were installed. 4 trees, 2 Betula Nigra and 2 Cercis Can, were installed with Bumper Crop Soil Amendment.
